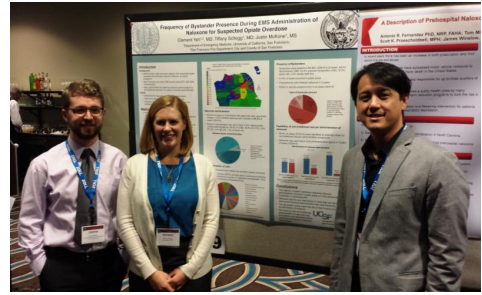

**Dr. Teri Reynolds**, Assistant Clinical Professor of Emergency Medicine, and **Dr. Andrea Tenner**, Assistant Clinical Professor of Emergency Medicine, were both speakers at the African Conference on Emergency Medicine (AfCEM) in Addis Ababa in November 2014. Dr. Reynolds spoke about "Novel strategies for teaching and learning EM in Africa - RAPs and Rex" and "Academia and Industry;" led sessions directing teams on evaluation of the burden of acute disease in Sub-Saharan Africa and the development of a universal medical documentation form; and, as Chair of the African Federation for Emergency Medicine (AFEM) Scientific Committee, presented on the committee's activities over the past year. Dr. Tenner chaired and moderated the research symposium presentations on the first day of the conference.
